

Plant of the week:

Hemerocallis

Hemerocallis 'Catherine Woodbury',
'Catherine Woodbury'
Daylily

Family: *Hemerocallidaceae*

Hardiness: Zones 3 - 9

Height: 24 - 36"

Leaves: Dark green grassy foliage



Flowers: 6" lightly ruffled fragrant pink flower with green throat that attracts butterflies and hummingbirds.

Culture: Prefers moist/dry soil in full sun/partial shade. My Catherine Woodbury daylilies were transplanted in the back garden in 1999. Every July/August I look forward to seeing their satisfying trumpet- like blooms which are situated near a number of English lavender plants.

Hybridized by Childs, Year of Registration or Introduction 1967. Award of Merit 1973.
